## About the Scholarship

The New York State Historical Association, the New York State Archives Partnership Trust, and the New York Council for the Humanities are committed to the purpose of furthering the advancement of historical scholarship and advocacy within the State of New York. For the first time this year, a limited number of scholarships are being offered to students and municipal historians in order to encourage their professional development and to advance the work done by the organizations with which they are involved. Applicants are required to submit this application form, a current resume, proof of student status (if applicable), and a brief (250 words or less) essay that describes how your attendance at the Conference on New York State History will benefit your professional development as both a scholar and advocate of the field of history.

Conference scholarships include complimentary registration as well as a partial stipend that may be used for travel, accommodations, or meals. Stipends can either be received by a check for the full amount, or may be applied to registration for meals and conference events directly. Applications will be accepted beginning March 1st and must be **postmarked by April 27th** for consideration.

Applications will be evaluated following the deadline and awards will be presented based on qualification and merit. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance by **May 1st**.
